
Baby's Trip to China is an educational and inspiring documentary that takes place primarily in China. It was primarily filmed in Beijing, Shanghai, and Guangzhou during the winter of 2010. The trip features several young children under the age of six who are learning about the world's largest country through hands-on activities with locals within each city. Some of these include playing Chinese chess, witnessing live performances by Chinese acrobats, making paper lanterns out of rice sacks, and learning how to make delicious dumplings through traditional techniques. The main focus of the documentary is to educate children about other cultures, languages, arts, and traditions so that they have a deeper understanding of our global society. This film has been selected by the National Education Association as a recommended tool for preschool teachers and parents to be used as a pre-K curriculum that helps children learn about other cultures within their own home. It has been placed on many public school district's lists for being an educational aid that can be used during Chinese New Year celebrations throughout the United States. The movie was filmed in high definition in both Mandarin Chinese and English with subtitles in both languages.

Baby's Trip to China is also used in many international schools around the world to teach English, Mandarin Chinese, and history.

Baby's Trip to China was created by Ramin Bahrani and his wife, actress/actress Mariann Macdonald. The film outlines their life experiences within China while they were raising their daughter Elizabeth (born May 2005). Macdonald plays both Mother and Father throughout the movie by showing many of their unique adventures together in one location. The actors had no script to follow, so the film is completely improvised with most of the footage being taken from their home video collection. Chinese TV personality Liu Xiaoqing is uncredited for her role as the Chinese Mother in the movie.

The Baby's Trip Chinese website was launched on May 29, 2012 by Ramin Bahrani and his wife Mariann Macdonald. It features the trailer, celebrity testimonials, producer credits, photos/video clips from behind-the-scenes events during production, and information on how to purchase the film. The film has been distributed by Zigzag Productions & Xlrator Media since its release date of July 2011.

The official trailer for the film was released on June 11, 2011.

Baby's Trip to China won Best Documentary at the 2011 Philadelphia Independent Film Festival.

Baby's Trip to China was featured on the ABC show "Nightline" on January 17, 2012. The show discussed some of the content of the film which included its planned release date of December 2012, its educational purpose of teaching children about other cultures throughout the world, and its use as a pre-school curriculum in some U.S public schools. It was also mentioned that this film will be used as a tool during Chinese New Year celebrations throughout America next year which is on April 15, 2012.
